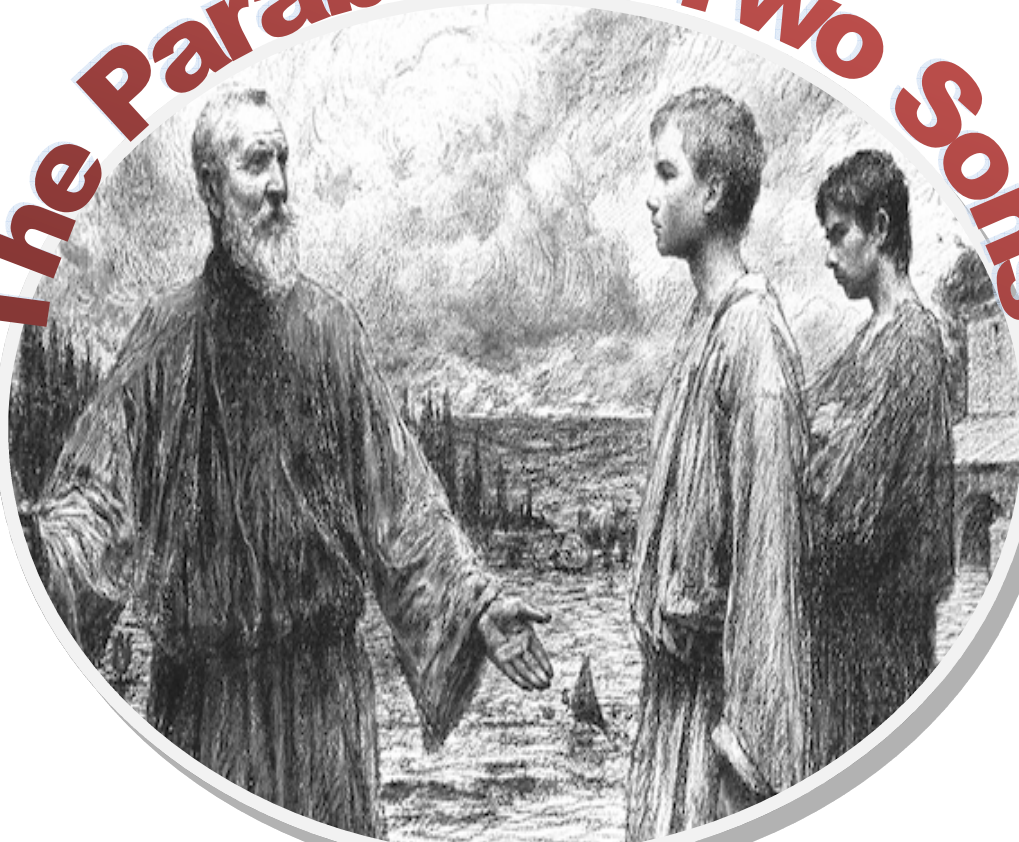

About the Music: Today's postlude is one of the most famous organ pieces in the repertoire. Charles-Marie Widor (1844-1937) wrote ten organ symphonies, and the Toccata from the Fifth Symphony is played regularly in churches all over the world, frequently at Easter services. Herbert Howells (1892-1983) was a British composer known for his Anglican church music, as well as his *Hymnus Paradisi* for soprano and tenor soloists, mixed chorus and orchestra, commemorating the death of his young son Michael (one of Howell's hymn tunes is also named MICHAEL.) Sally Ann Morris lives and works in North Carolina and writes hymn tunes and hymn anthems.
