Announcing the Motor City Mission Fellowship

We are really excited to be able to announce what the Motor City Mission Corps has been working on for the past couple months! We've taken the time to look closely at our previous program and what it means to do ministry with young adults. We are taking a new approach to what it means to explore issues of vocation, calling and leadership with young adults.

The Motor City Mission Fellowship is seeking young adults with a passion to lift up their communities. Participants will receive a grant of up to \$3000 to start a new ministry project. Motor City Mission Corps will come alongside them for three months to help make a plan, provide a community and resources to get their new work off the ground. These projects will be done in partnership with organizations already at work in the community and with the Presbytery of Detroit.

This Fellowship program will serve as a springboard, providing startup funding and logistical support to start work with those who otherwise may not be able to pursue their passion. Our program is three months long but projects will be built to have lasting impact, creating new opportunities for young adult leadership in the church and growing the ministry community of Metro Detroit.

We are hoping that our first group can start in January 2018.
